1. INTRODUCTION

EVS continues to build on the functionality of replay operator tools, in response to user feedback. In this newsletter we highlight the new XFile3 version 6. Epsio Live has also been updated to be compatible with the latest Multicam Software.

Epsio Live

To ensure compatibility with the latest Multicam software we've released software version 2.1 of Epsio Live.

XFile3

XFile3 moves from version 5 to version 6. It's now possible to connect and operate XFile3 without an XT server in your network. We've also integrated the VIA Licensing platform and, in the back end, VIA Xsquare is included in the software package of XFile.

2. EPSIO LIVE

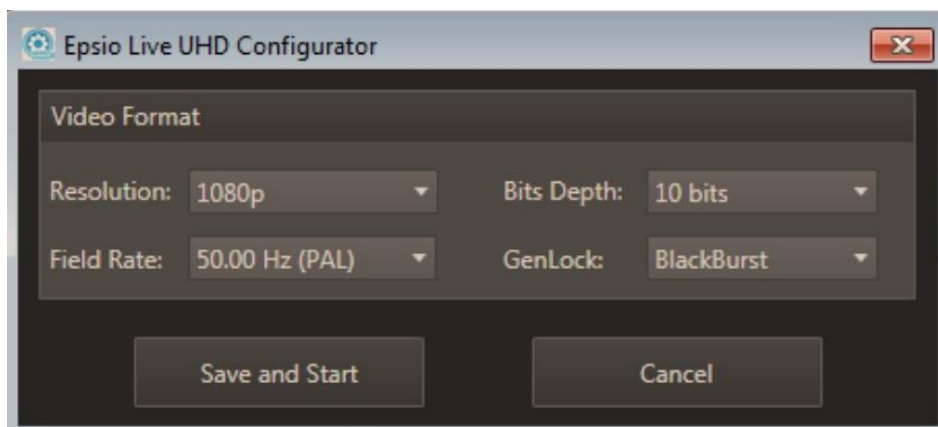
Epsio Live is used to integrate live graphics into your live production. You can quickly draw an offside line, insert a score or logos on the field, or add a distance to a goal.

2.1. COMPATIBILITY WITH XT-VIA

Upgrading your Epsio Live to version 2.1 will ensure compatibility with our latest XT-VIA servers and the latest Multicam 20.1 release.



2.2. 1080P SUPPORT



Epsio Live is now enhanced with support for the 1080p format. On the Epsio workstation you can configure the video format in the configurator. Select the Epsio Live UHD Configurator in the Epsio Live UHD menu to setup the configuration. Make sure you select the same resolution, bit rate, bits depth and genlock that is defined in the configuration of the EVS Server you are going to work with.

3. XFILE3

XFile3 has also been upgraded to version 6.0 to support the new VIA Platform. VIA Xsquare is now also integrated into XFile3. Find out more about VIA Xsquare on our website. Alongside the VIA platform integrations, we also now support up to 34 servers, offer the possibility to work offline and have added more information when exporting Playlist EDL files. When archiving super motion clips, you now can include audio. Finally, we've also introduced encoder profiles.

3.1. OFFLINE MODE

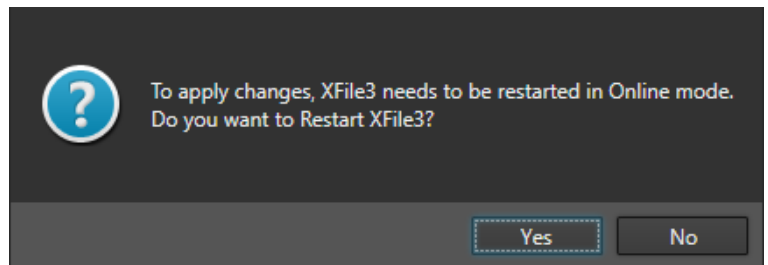
As of version 6.0 you can start your XFile3 in Offline Mode. That means you can still launch XFile3, even if there are no XT servers available in your VLAN.

In Offline Mode you can only access the Media Manager Tab.

Servers in the same VLAN will not be automatically discovered when they start up during your XFile3 session in Offline Mode. You'll have to reboot the XFile3 software to switch to Online Mode.

After the restart, XFile3 will be in Online Mode and all the servers which have been selected from the settings in the Discovery Tab will be displayed (if they are reachable by the network).

In Offline Mode you can access the Server Discovery tab in the Settings. Here you can manually discover a server that is outside of your VLAN. Enter the IP Address of your server in the PC LAN Address field and click "add" to discover the server. Once this is done you can apply, or save and quit. Both options will show a popup message asking you if you want to restart your XFile3 software.



3.2. PLAYLIST EDL CONTAINS MORE INFORMATION

The following information has been added to Playlist EDLs when a Playlist is archived with XFile3.

- CamPref
- XTClip ID
- XT Server Name
- XT Server User Number
- Var ID

This added information is now closer to the EDL generated by IPDirector.

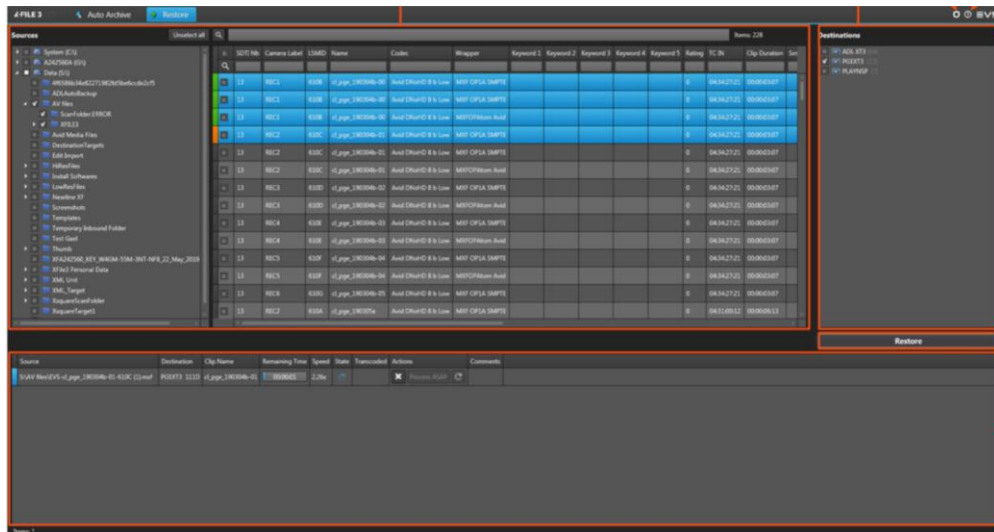
3.3. VIA XSQUARE 4.1

XFile3 version 6.0 integrates VIA Xsquare so it benefits from the new features of VIA Xsquare 4.1

- Better Performance
- SDR/HDR Conversions based on LUT
- SLSM 3x 4K-UHD (XAVCi/DNxHR)
- Restore ProRes 4444 QT MOV as Fill & Key on XT/XS
- XT/XS-VIA H.264 Proxy Transfer (backup/stream to storage)

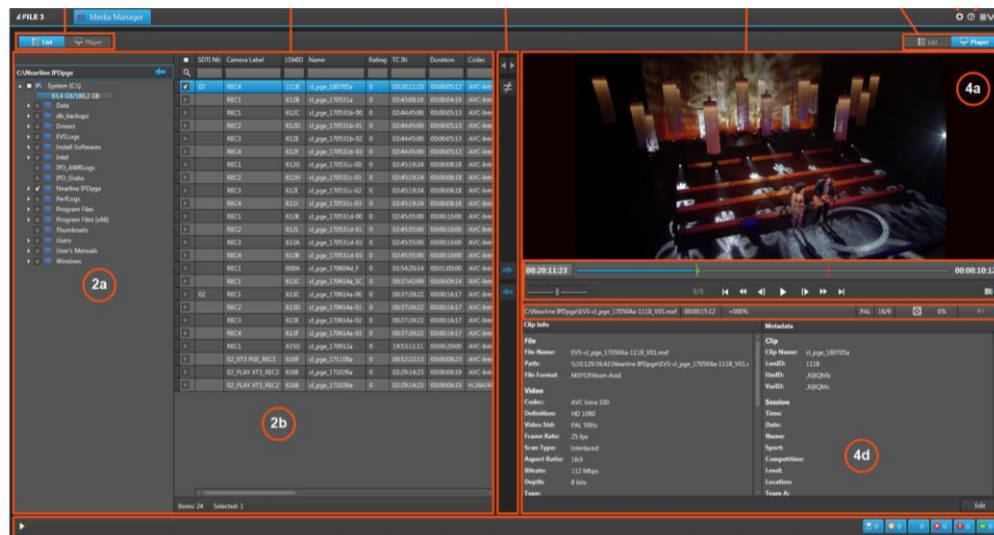

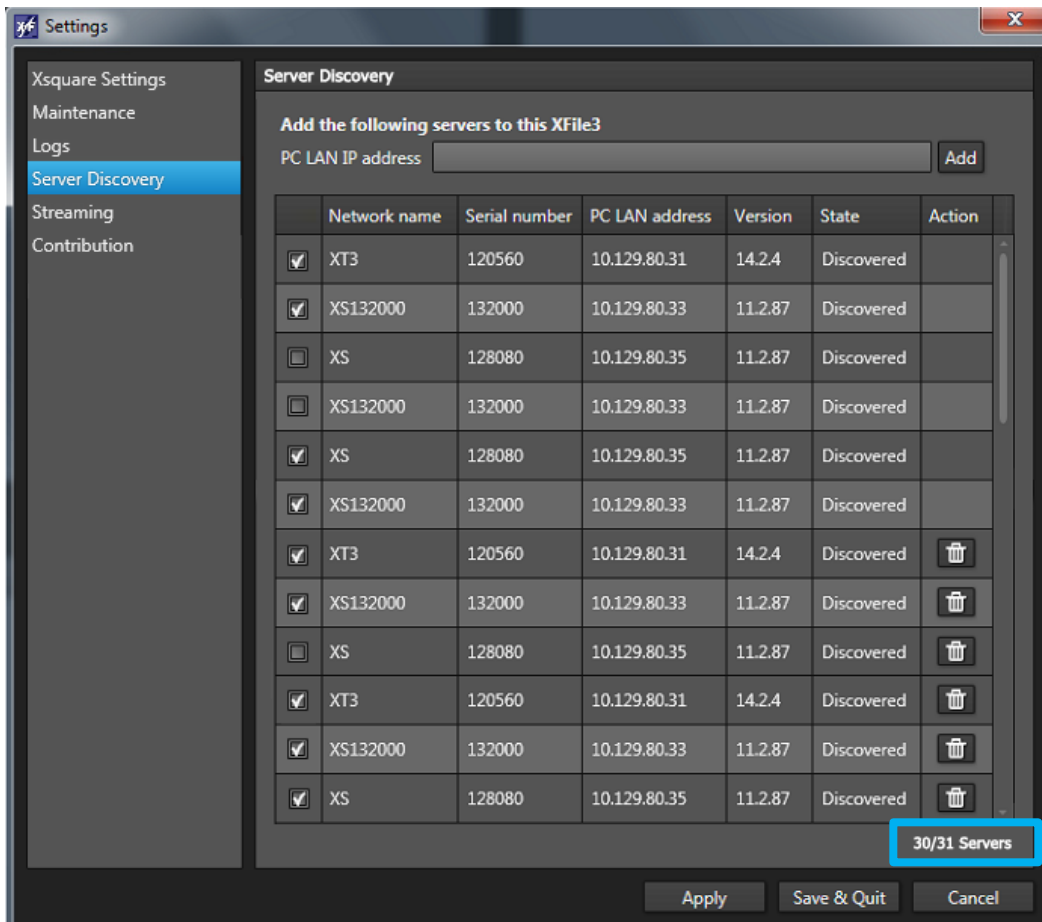
XFILE3 LITE – MEDIA MANAGER

The Media Manager License offers you two lists where you can list, sort and copy your media from two locations at the same time. The job status can be monitored from a Jobs Monitoring pane. It also offers the possibility to preview clips in the built-in player. The player can read EVS .mxf files, .xml files and SLSM EVS .mxf files. Alongside the preview capabilities you can also trim a clip and update or edit the metadata file. These capabilities enable producers to (p)review content on hard disks, assign LSM-IDs during per-production or change clip names before transferring from the disk to the server.



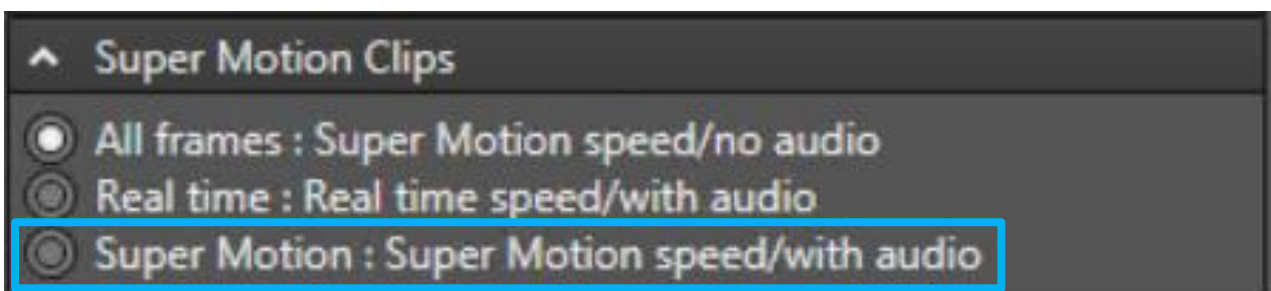
3.5. NEW XNET-VIA SIZE

As of Multicam 20.1, users taking advantage of the XNet-VIA network on their XT-VIA can benefit from an expanded network of up to 34 servers. XFile3 version 6.1 makes it possible to Display all 34 Servers in the Discovery Tab.



3.6. ARCHIVE SUPER MOTION CLIPS WITH AUDIO

A new option is added when exporting Super Motion Clips: "Super Motion: Super Motion speed/with audio". When selecting this option all the frames of the Super Motion Clip are kept with the synchronized audio. Please keep in mind that this option only works when you use an EVS mxf wrapper and you are limited to transcoding profiles with codecs that are natively present on the EVS video server.



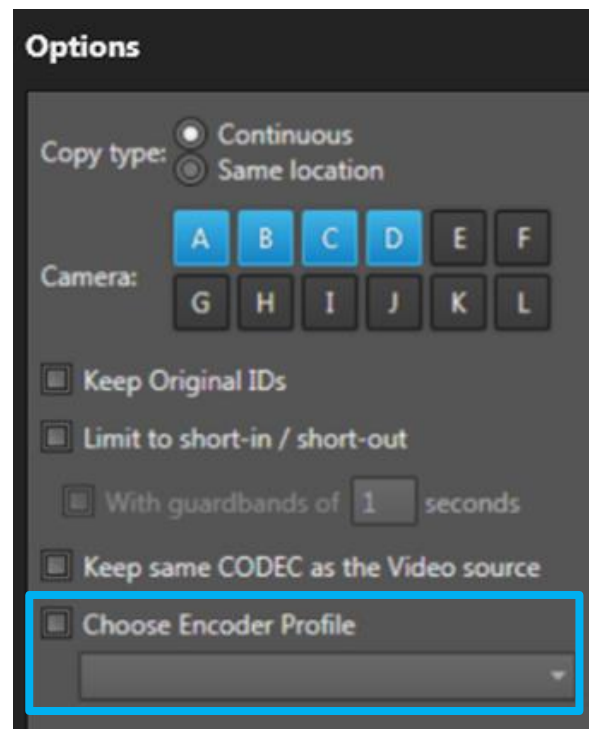
3.7. ENCODER PROFILES

In the Restore tab a new option is made available in version 6.1. You now have an Encoder Profile drop down menu available from which you can select an encoder profile from a list.

With the Encoder Profiles Manager Tool you can make available Encoder Profiles to select from in the Options section. The following encoder profiles are available:

- Last Used: Encoders Profiles used recently by the user. (They are not kept after restart)
- User: Encoder Profiles the user has created in Xsquare
- Default: Default Encoder Profiles suggested by Xsquare

If needed you can export or import your Encoder Profiles to/from another XFile3.
