

YEPCO SOFTWARE LICENSE AGREEMENT

This End User License Agreement (“Agreement”) is entered into between **YEPCO** (“Licensor”) and the end user (“End User”).

The YEPCO software (“Software”) is provided as part of a product supplied by **EVS** (the “Product”).

By installing or using the Software, the End User agrees to the terms of this Agreement.

1. License Grant

YEPCO grants the End User a non-exclusive, non-transferable license to use the Software solely as embedded within the Product and in accordance with the documentation.

The Software is licensed, not sold.

The Software may only be used for the End User’s internal business purposes.

2. Scope and Restrictions

The Software may only be used as integrated in the Product.

The End User may not:

- copy, modify, or distribute the Software
- reverse engineer or attempt to extract source code, algorithms, or models
- bypass license key or security mechanisms
- use the Software beyond the licensed number of systems
- use the Software as a standalone product
- use the Software to develop competing products.

3. License Keys

Use of the Software may require license keys provided by YEPCO.

License keys:

- are specific to the Product
- may not be shared or reused
- may not be modified or bypassed.

Unauthorized use may result in suspension of the Software.**4. Artificial Intelligence / Machine Learning**

The Software may include artificial intelligence (AI), machine learning (ML), or automated decision components.

The End User acknowledges that:

- AI outputs may not always be complete, accurate, or error-free
- results generated by the Software require human review
- the Software is intended as a decision-support tool.

The End User shall not:

- attempt to extract, replicate, or train competing models using the Software
- use the Software to create datasets intended to replicate YEPCO technology
- use automated methods to analyse the Software for model extraction.

YEPCO retains all rights to models, algorithms, and training methodologies used in the Software.

4. Intellectual Property

The Software and related technology are proprietary to YEPCO and its licensors.

All intellectual property rights remain the exclusive property of YEPCO.

No ownership rights are transferred.

5. Support

Level 1 support is provided by EVS.

Level 2 and Level 3 support related to the Software may be provided by YEPCO via EVS.

End Users shall contact EVS for support requests.

6. Data and Usage Information

The Software may collect technical and diagnostic information related to:

- license validation
- system compatibility
- performance optimization.

No personal content is intentionally collected.

Processing of personal data, if any, shall comply with applicable data protection laws.

7. Warranty Disclaimer

The Software is provided “as is”, except as otherwise agreed in writing.

YEPCO does not guarantee uninterrupted or error-free operation.

The Software is designed to operate within the Product environment provided by EVS.

8. Limitation of Liability

To the maximum extent permitted by law, YEPCO shall not be liable for:

- loss of revenue
- loss of production time
- loss of data
- indirect or consequential damages.

YEPCO liability shall be limited as defined in the agreement between YEPCO and EVS.

9. Termination

This license terminates automatically if the End User breaches this Agreement.

Upon termination, the End User must stop using the Software.

10. Governing Law

This Agreement shall be governed by applicable law as defined in the agreement between YEPCO and EVS.
